


This card was designed to fit an A9 envelope (5 3/4 x 8 3/4").

1. Cut 2 pieces of cardstock to 5.5" x 8.5".


2. Print this page (or page below) and tape to cardstock.

If using this page I recommend 7 stitches per normal size kernel (2 short on ends and 5 in middle), 6 stitches for the next two rows, and 5 for the smallest. I used an embroidery needle (size 3 I think). Use the smallest needle you can that still allows embroidery thread.

3. Punch holes and embroider.



You can print this page as template instead of the page above. These were my actual holes. However the holes were too close in the small kernels. I recommend fewer stitches here. (Yes, I am too lazy to make you a pdf with corrected holes! Sometime you just have to wing it!)



This is the Happy Thanksgiving template. I left the border holes on this template but I recommend taping both pieces of cardstock together and using one template (either the one above or this one) to punch the border holes. That way they will be exactly the same.
